Measurable Objective to Achieve Goal:

Even with an increased enrollment, HGS will decrease the number of office referrals by 5% from 221 to fewer than 210 office referrals.

Strategies to Achieve Objectives:

- ➤ HGS will develop a timeline for applying to become a Diamond Award School
- ➤ Weekly character education classes for all students
- > Teachers actively teach (or review) the PBIS Matrix at the beginning of each reporting period
- ➤ HGS will use updated resources Harmony SEL and the complementary app to teach appropriate behavior
- ➤ Universal SEL Screener (SAEBRS) as part of the MTSS framework of our school
- ➤ Counseling groups for students identified at risk during the SAEBRS screening (proactive)
- > Staff will be provided two in-house trainings per year in the area of Social-Emotional Learning

- > ½ Day Collaborative Planning for all other grade level contents to update and strengthen their Units of Study
- ➤ Have teachers complete their individual instructional framework and define each component of their ICE.
- ➤ Have teachers collectively complete their core problem solving and determine where to build in supplemental instructional support.
- ➤ Teacher Walk-throughs with ICE Feedback

- ➤ Collaborative Planning day for 4<sup>th</sup> Grade Math to create Units of Study
- ➤ Grade-Levels will meet after the completion of each Unit of Study to review concept mastery, growth data, and adjust the Unit of Study
- ➤ Identify a teacher leader to share resources with staff for the implementation of Pre- and Post-Test data collection aimed to track student growth
- ➤ Intervention groups will be built and drive small group instruction during our "What I Need" (WIN) intervention block
